Title IX Review

Bryan Station High School's administration efforts to ensure equity and integrity athletics have instituted the following requirements for our coaches and boosters to monitor our athletic spending.

- 1) BSHS along with all other FCPS high schools now have mandatory Booster Club training sessions throughout the year that are attended by the head coach and booster club presidents. Trainings are led by Mr. Donald Adkins, who is the Fayette County District Athletic Director.
- 2) Booster Club agreements are required to be on file at the school for all active booster club groups that support athletic programs.
- 3) All Bryan Station coaches attend a training with the Finance Officer of BSHS and sign off on the proper procedures for purchases.
- 4) Any and all donations have to be approved by the gender equity committee, Athletic Director, and Principal. After school approval the donation intention is sent to the Superintendent of Fayette County for final approval before any monies or inventory are awarded to any athletic programs.
- 5) All purchase orders are approved by the Principal before any order is processed through the school bookkeeper.
- 6) Booster club contact information is updated yearly and kept on file by our bookkeeper at Bryan Station High School for any questions impacting fundraising and expenditures.
- 7) Any major purchase by any athletic program has to be approved by the Title IX/Gender Equity Committee and the principal before purchased.
