For boys and girls basketball, the squad cheers all home games and county games. In some instances, the entire squad will cheer. If there is a double header varsity game, the squad is divided into two squads and each cheers one of the games. The individual cheerleaders are assigned the same number of boys' varsity games and girls' varsity games.

Bullitt Central Co-Ed Cheerleaders take part in various competitions.

The marching band plays and performs a half-time show at three home varsity football games. During basketball, they play at all double header varsity games. They also play at the girls' varsity senior night and boys' varsity senior night games. The dance team performs at varsity double header basketball games only.
