Tryouts are held in May of the preceding school year. The tryouts includes two days of clinic (preparation for tryouts), and one day of actual evaluations. Placements are based on skill, motions, jumps, standing tumbling, running tumbling, dance, and stunting. Five judges are used with scores ranging from 1 (low) to 10 (high) in each area. Number of girls selected varies each year and seniors have priority placement to the varsity squad.

4. How is each cheerleading squad assigned to home and away athletic contests? Include football as well as boys' and girls' basketball (and any other sport) at the varsity and junior varsity levels. Include any rotation plans or alternating game assignments that your squads follow.

Football season the JV squad cheers the JV football games and the varsity cheer for varsity football games. For basketball, the cheerleading squads only cheer for varsity games. The number of games cheered by each squad is spread out evenly. A schedule is set at the beginning of the season with equal amounts of road/home games and boys/girls games.

5. Name any squad(s) that takes part in competitive cheerleading events.

A competition squad is derived from both varsity and jv squads. Participation on this squad is optional with a maximum of 30 participants.
