<p>Butler County High School</p>	<p>Athletic Travel, Meals and Overnight Accommodations Policy</p>	<p><u>Adopted:</u> January 2011 <u>Revised:</u> February 2017 Policy 1</p>
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For groups or teams who qualify to compete at the state level, the Butler County Board of Education will pay for the mileage, buses and drivers, meals and accommodations. These trips must be in compliance with Butler County Board Policy number 09.36 – School Related Student Trips. A written itinerary must also be turned in to the BCHS Administration.

All other sport travel that may incur any of the above mentioned expenses may be paid by BCHS by submitting a Request for Purchase and pending approval from administration. These trips must still comply with Butler County Board Policy number 09.36 as well as a written itinerary being provided:

The following guidelines shall be followed regarding meals and overnight accommodations:

- At maximum, two meals per day can be paid for by the booster club. Other meals must be bought by the team members.
- Meal price is \$8.00 to \$10.00 per athlete with a maximum limit of \$20 per day.
- Hotel Accommodations will be paid for with booster club money. For Regional and/or State Competitions, accommodations will be paid for by the Butler County Board of Education.
- Room Rates should be no more than approximately \$100 per night for each room.
- It is suggested that 3-4 players should be assigned to each room.

The following guidelines shall be followed regarding modes of transportation:

- If transporting no more than 6 students, a school owned van may be used to transport.
- If transporting 7 or more students, a bus shall be used to transport.
- In certain circumstances a charter bus may be used but only with prior administrative approval.
