

## Shared Facilities Schedule

### Soccer Fields

On Even number years, girls will have early practice on the main field the first week of season. Boys will have early practice on the main field the second week of season.

On odd number years, boys will have early practice on the main field the first week of season. Girls will have early practice on the main field the second week of season.

If there are questions regarding the use of the fields, this rotation will be extended through the dead period.

### Gymnasium

Volleyball will have priority beginning after the dead period as practice begins for their season.

### Basketball

On Even number years, girls will have early practice the first week of season. Boys will have early practice the second week of season.

On odd number years, boys will have early practice the first week of season. Girls will have early practice second week of season.

If there are questions regarding the use of the fields, this rotation will be extended through the dead period.

There is a facilities dry erase calendar posted for this facility for times when this rotation must be changed and is agreed upon by the coaches.

## Awards Guidelines

### Calloway County high School

In regards to awards, we are evaluating the implementation of different possibilities. We at this time have no specific policies regarding awards, banquets, or the display of jerseys. Banners are in place for the recognition of regional championships and state accomplishments. The retirement of jerseys required board approval but do not have a list of accomplishments that must be met. We are evaluating the possibility of transforming our current stage inside the gymnasium into an athletic hall of fame. This would remove the pictures and jerseys from our gym walls and move them into our potential hall of fame. With banquets, we are in the process of hopefully coordinating a consolidated end of the year banquet for each season. This would allow all sports of a season to have a banquet together and break into separate groups for their awards portion of the banquet. Neither item has achieved final approval at this time.

# Athletic Transportation

## Calloway County High School

In regards to transportation of Calloway County Athletes. Following are the guidelines regarding the use of school buses, suburbans, and charter buses.

### Charter Buses

Trips beyond 150 miles required board approval. For trips that required board approval that sport may choose to submit a request for the use of a charter bus. This would be the sole responsibility of that group or sport to cover all expenses for the use of this service.

### Suburbans

A suburban can be requested when the group has less than eight students who will be traveling. When buses are available, they will be required to use buses as they are considered to be the safest form of transportation. When buses are not available such as times where the students need to leave school early or before a route driver can be available.

### Buses

Buses will be taken on all trips where eight or more students will be traveling and all other trips that do not meet the exceptions listed above.

## Weight Training Facility

Inside our weight facility we had a dry erase board for the scheduling of the facility. It was recommended that we add a second dry erase board for the upstairs portion of the facility. That has been added allowing our teams to sign up for either area.
