With the close of the 2003-2004 school year, the Kentucky High School Athletic Association completed its initial five-year Title IX implementation plan. In partnership with the Kentucky Department of Education, the KHSAA is maintaining an ongoing effort to ensure Title IX compliance among all KHSAA member schools.

In that light, approximately thirty (30) member schools have been identified to participate in an ongoing Title IX Review during the 2006-2007 school year. Your school was among those chosen to take part in this update. We will, once again, visit your school to ascertain the progress made in attaining athletic equity for male and female students/athletes. The purpose of this memorandum is to assist you in preparing for this visit by KHSAA Audit Team members.

First, please complete the attached forms and return them to the KHSAA office no later than October 1, 2006. Every effort was made to reduce the amount of paperwork and to request the needed information in a clear and concise manner.

The aim of a couple of the included charts is to summarize the status of your program during the past five years. Consequently, it is imperative that you use information that is a part of the Annual Reports for 2001-2002, 2002-2003, 2003-2004, 2004-2005 and 2005-2006. Also, regarding the Annual Reports you have submitted, it has been the practice of the KHSAA to forward a copy to you of any corrected sheets in which there was an error in your calculations and/or submissions. Be sure to also refer to these corrected sheets when reporting the 2006-2007 information.

Second, you will be notified regarding the specific date for the visit. The visit will consist of a number of components. We ask that the required information be made available and that arrangements be made for the activities listed on the following page. An estimated timetable for the day of the visit is also presented.

- Written policies regarding awards and recognition of athletic accomplishments pertaining to both genders
- Written designation of locker room and storage space assigned each team
- Written booster club agreements
- District planning documents for attaining athletic gender equity
- School generated athletic handbooks

 - Guided tour of indoor and outdoor athletic-related facilities (1:30 pm 3:00 pm)
 - Selected interviews (3:00 pm 4:00 pm)

 - C. One male and one female athlete, each from different sports (hopefully, these students are members of the Gender Equity Review Committee)

We thank you for your participation in this Title IX Review. Also, we commend you and your Gender Equity Review Committee for making advancements in achieving parity for female and male participants. The commitment of school personnel and community members in enhancing opportunities and benefits is resulting in improved educational programs for Kentucky's student athletes.

Dear Bill Dickens:

Pursuant to 702 KAR 7:065, the Kentucky High School Athletic Association has been directed to assist member schools in monitoring compliance with Title IX. Part of this assessment process includes reviewing the progress schools are making with their Gender Equity Review Committees and Title IX plans. KHSAA member schools will be visited this year, and subsequent years until every school has been visited. KHSAA Audit Staff members may be accompanied by KDE personnel on these visits.

We have scheduled **November 17th** as the audit date for **Calvary Christian** High School. The audit will begin at 2:30 P.M., and will consist of the following, in this order:

- The Principal or Athletic Director should be prepared to accompany the KHSAA auditors
 on a tour of all athletic facilities, including all locker rooms, all meeting rooms, coaches'
 offices, storage facilities, all practice and competition areas, and any other facility used by
 the athletic department. The KHSAA auditors will ask to see your school's permanent
 Title IX file upon their arrival.
- On display for the KHSAA auditors to review should be examples of team uniforms from each boys' and girls' athletic team.
- The KHSAA auditors will meet with your school's Gender Equity Review Committee
 at approximately 4:00 P.M. All committee members, if possible, should be in attendance,
 particularly your school's Title IX Coordinator. During this meeting, the KHSAA auditors
 will discuss your athletic program in detail. Your Gender Equity Review Committee
 should be prepared with pertinent information pertaining to your school's original 19992000 Audit Document and updated 2002-2003 Title IX forms.
- The KHSAA auditors will conduct a public comment session at 6:00 P.M. in your Library for the purpose of allowing any interested parties the opportunity to ask questions regarding gender equity and Title IX, as well as the overall athletics program at your school. Members of your administrative staff and representatives of your Title IX Committee should be present for this session. The KHSAA will alert the local media of this session in order to notify interested parties who may wish to attend.
