2. SCHEDULING PRIORITY WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:
 - a. EVEN NUMBERED CALENDAR DAYS SOFTBALL 2:30-3:30, BASEBALL 3:30-4:30
 - b. ODD NUMBERED CALENDAR DAYS BASEBALL 2:30-3:30, SOFTBALL 3:30-4:30
3. NOTIFY THE ATHLETIC OFFICE IF YOUR TEAM(S) ARE NOT GOING TO USE YOUR TIME SLOT ON EVEN GIVEN DAY.

WEIGHT ROOM SCHEDULING GUIDELINES

1. THE WEIGHT ROOMS ARE AVAILABLE FOR EACH CCHS TEAM WHO WOULD LIKE TO SCHEDULE A TIME TO USE THEM.
2. SCHEDULES WILL BE RELEASED AND POSTED MONTHLY.
3. A SCHEDULE WILL BE PRODUCED MONTHLY FOR ALL SPORTS IN SEASON AND ONES WHO DESIRE TO HAVE ACCESS. IF ASSIGNED TEAM DOES NOT USE ROOM – OTHER TEAM MAY REQUEST THAT TIME SLOT.
4. A SCHEDULE WILL BE PRODUCED THAT REFLECTS EQUALITY TO ALL CCHS TEAMS WISHING TO USE THE WEIGHT ROOMS.
5. PRIORITY WILL BE GIVEN TO GIRLS AND BOYS TEAMS WHO ARE IN SEASON, FOLLOWED BY THE NEXT UPCOMING SEASON.

The Campbell County High School Suburban Use Policy for Athletic events is as follows:

Athletic teams that consist of 7 members or fewer may request use of the district Suburban. A normal bus request should be submitted to the athletic office for approval no later than two weeks before the event. It should be indicated on the top of the request form that the team is request use of the Suburban. The head coach (or other paid coach) is responsible for contacting Central Office to complete the proper driver paperwork prior to the use of the Suburban.

Also, below is an update on our plan to address the accessibility issue with our number of coaches. The final steps will be included on our T-60 form with this year's Title IX submission on or before April 30.

PARITY IN ACCESSIBILITY TO COACHING

The Campbell County High School Title IX committee will, at its end of winter meeting, discuss ways to bring about more parity in the accessibility to coaching for all CCHS athletes. In review of the issue, it is clear that the cause of the disparity is the number of volunteer coaches in the male sports of football, baseball, and to some extent wrestling. As noted in the re-visit report of October 23, 2014, the review of the district's extra service pay schedule showed parity. Thus steps will be put into place to address the overall disparity. Below are the questions/statements that will be used in the discussion to develop the final plan. The final steps will be outlined and included on the April 30, 2015 Title IX report form T-60.

1. What is each committee member's thoughts on how we go about getting parity with the number of volunteer coaches for each sport/gender?
2. How do we actively recruit volunteer coaches for female sports to equal the number of interested volunteers for male sports?
3. Do we look at a limitation of the number of volunteer coaches allowed for each sport?
4. Should like sports be required to have the same number of volunteer coaches, if any are interested?

Example: Basketball, Soccer, Etc.

5. A coach who volunteers for a sport in which both genders practice/compete at the same time should work with both teams and be listed on the KHSAA coaches list as a coach for both teams. Example: Boys/Girls Track and Field, Boys/Girls Tennis, Etc.

6. What guidelines do we use to insure that a volunteer coach is truly needed and/or beneficial to the team versus just wanting to be a part of the program and not truly adding any benefit to the program?
