**Post Season Banquets for Student Athletes**

**Caverna High School will use the following guidelines and regulations for Post Season Banquets for Student athletes:**

**The Caverna HS Fall Sports Banquet will take place for Football, Boys and Girls Golf, Volleyball, and Boys and Girls Cross Country on Monday, Nov 20, 2017**

**The Caverna HS Winter Sports Banquet will take place for Girls and Boys Basketball, Bowling on Monday, March 5.**

**The Caverna HS Spring Sports Banquet will take place for Boys and Girls Tennis, Softball, Baseball, and Girls and Boys Track, on Monday May 21, 2017  
(Pending ends of seasons)**

Each team will have common awards to give out including Mvp award, selected by team, and presented with a Caverna MVP Plaque to cost between \$10-15. Each team will issue academic awards to those with higher than 3.2 GPA. **Each team will be allotted between \$5-10 per student athlete of their teams.** This can go towards various individual sports accomplishments and recognitions.

Girls and Boys Basketball will give the same awards and spend the same amount.

Baseball and Softball will give the same awards and spend the same amount.

Boys and Girls Tennis, Track, and Cross Country will all give same awards for boys and girls and spend equal for each gender on the teams.

*\*\* The only difference in spending could be with number of certificates for academic awards but this will be minimal.*
