-Cheerleaders will attend all FB games home, away, and post season.
-Cheerleaders will attend all G/B basketball home and post season games with all members attending each designated game. The squad will be divided into two groups. One group will cheer on the floor the 1st half while the other group will be in the student section. At half, they will rotate positions—group two will be on the floor and group one will move to the student section. The two groups will simply alternate who starts each game on the floor. (We have 21 cheerleaders. It is impossible to place them all on the floor at the same time. To ensure that each cheerleader has equal opportunities, the previous system was devised.)
