**CLINTON COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL
AWARDS AND BANQUETS
STUDENT ATHLETE GUIDELINES**

AWARD BANQUETS

- All sports awards banquets for student athletes at Clinton County High School will be held in the cafeteria of Clinton County High School. If a specific sport or a team in a specific sport desires to hold their sports awards banquet in another location, they must receive advance approval from either the principal of Clinton County High School or the Athletic Director at Clinton County High School.
- The meal that is being served at the sports banquet is to the discretion of the coaches involved dependent upon the available funds to cover the expense associated with the food and preparation. The cost of the food and preparation shall not exceed \$500 per team/per sport for a sports award banquet. Any exceptions to this policy will be addressed on an at needs basis and must be approved by the principal of Clinton County High School or the Athletic Director of Clinton County High School.

AWARDS

- Awards presented to student athletes shall not exceed \$40 per player per year. Awards given to athletes shall be at the discretion of the coaches of the individual teams and based upon the available funds to cover the expense of the awards. Any exceptions to this policy will be addressed on an at needs basis and must be approved by the principal or athletic director of Clinton County High School.
