Corbin High School Athletic Awards/Banquet Policy

of yet 15-14

The athletic programs at Corbin High School *may* recognize the achievement of student-athletes that participate in sponsored sports and sport activities. An appropriate event *may* be held to recognize the achievement of all student-athletes that meet the criteria.

It is the *option* of each athletic team to provide a banquet following the completion of their sport season to honor participating athletes. Sport banquets should be near the end or shortly after the completion of the season.

The Corbin Independent School District *may* provide facilities for the event if needed but will <u>not</u> be responsible for debts incurred.

The head coach is responsible for all facets of the end-of season awards/banquet. The head coach *may* delegate these responsibilities to a booster club; however, the program and the agenda *must* be approved by the head coach. If a speaker is needed, the head coach is responsible for selecting this individual and coordinating his/her appearance. Head coaches *must* inform the Athletic Director of their intent to hold a banquet and a date should be selected to avoid conflicts with other activities.

The awards given out at the banquet are the sole responsibility of the head coach. Awards *may* be purchased by the team's booster clubs. The number and amount of these awards to be spent *must* be approved by the principal or athletic director to ensure compliance with Title IX standards.

Fundraising *may* be conducted to collect money to offset the cost of items for the banquet: however the **mandatory** collection of money from all students/parents to support the banquet and/or the purchase of awards for students and/or coaches is *prohibited*.

In years when, individually, Football, Volleyball, Boys Basketball, and Girls Basketball are revenue producing programs, the expense of awards and/or banquet for these individual programs *may* have 'limited' financial support of the General Athletic fund from gate receipts. This exclusively refers to awards and catered meal (ONLY meals of team members from KHSAA online roster and head table).

The principal and the athletic director will primarily monitor teams and/or booster clubs to assure equity in spending for all athletic awards and banquets through (1) the above requirement of communication by the head coach to the Athletic Director, (2) obtained approval of Athletic Director, and (3) approval/review of proposed spending or spending recorded by the High School's bookkeeper/booster clubs.
