2. Head coach and coach's assistant will help select team.
3. This group of five adults will set the criteria for selection.
4. Practice will take place for two weeks then the selection committee will hold a public tryout and choose the team.

Game assignment

Cheerleaders will cheer at all home games and select local games. Coaches will select the local away games to cheer. An equal number of Boy's and Girl's away games will be selected and approved by the Athletic Director to assure equity.

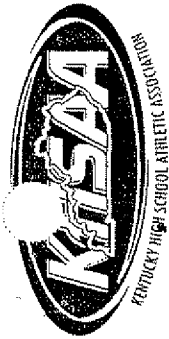
