With the upgrades to the softball complex at Daviness County High School nearing completion, I wanted to give you an update on progress toward that end. My last letter indicated that the project was to be completed by December 1, however, the contractors have run into two minor problems, which have delayed completion, but should be remedied soon. Those issues concern:

1. Re-routing of a gas line on the property, and
2. Modifications to the drainage system.

Once those two items are completed, the project should be complete and ready for use by the DCHS Softball Team. As mentioned previously, all structures, including hitting building, concession stands, and other upgrades have been erected. Please let me know if further information is needed. When the next status report is due, all work should be completed, the contractors should be off-site, the facilities should be inspected, and the Daviness County High Softball Team should be using the facility. .
