Banquets and Post Season Awards

It is the responsibility of the Head Coach coordinate the Post Season Awards for their specific sport. The Athletic Director is available to help with logistics for each coach and sport.

Each specific sports fund is to be used for pay for the banquet. It is up to the coach to decide whether the banquet will be catered or a pot luck type meal with the help of the parents. If the event is catered, the sports fund is pay for the PLAYERS MEAL ONLY. The fund is not to pay for family member's meal. Each family is responsible for paying for themselves and other family members besides the athlete of that sport.

Each specific sport is responsible for paying for any specific awards other than the schools letters, pins and bars that are given out during the banquets. The SAF will pay for the letters, pins and bars for each athlete that is eligible for said award. The athlete will bring their certificate of letter award to the Athletic Director to receive their letter etc.

Any awards given out having to do with individual awards regarding season stats or team voted on awards are the responsibility of the specific team and their funds account.

Subject: FCHS Title IX Facilities response

Mr. McKinnon, Ms. Keenan, Ms. Muck and Gary Evans Sorry I meant to get this to you last night; I have run it up the chain of command with no complaints, additions or subtractions. Below is the Facilities response:

Short Term:

Fort Campbell High School Softball press box/storage facility (PSF) is currently in the design, estimation and funding process. This could either a temporary or permanent structure based the FY 15 Design process for the Fort Campbell Athletic Fields repair and replace effort.

- PSF would constructed on the current site utilizing the existing press box 12' X 12' concrete slab.
 - PSF would consist of a two story building with upper room being the press box, home/away book and the ground elevation room serving as the storage room.
 - PSF would be constructed with concrete block (CMU) on a poured footer, second story floor would be constructed with treated lumber and tongue/groove plywood floor; roofing would be pitched standing seam metal roof (pewter gray to match school colors as close as possible) on treated lumber trusses.
 - PSF would have a small electrical service that would power two florescent fixtures in the press box and storage room and to be determine a number 2-4 gang electrical boxes based on NEC and electrical panel capacity.
 - PSF would have two lockable metal doors; storage room door would 36", upper press box 32" door; press box window would consist of 60" X 30" sliding glass lockable window facing playing field.
 - PSF upper press box area would be serviced by 36" wide stairs with handrails that would constructed with treated lumber and non-slip stair treads.
 - PSF (block and doors) would be finished with an excellent grade of acrylic paint in schools colors.
- Construction and labor force could consist of a combination of Fort Knox Maintenance and Fort Campbell Grounds personnel. This would require use of TDY and current sustainment funding.

Construction could contracted by a USACE.

Since the current press box is in reasonably good condition the Fort Campbell Schools Total Maintenance Contract is probably not a vehicle in which to replace the existing structure with the required upgrades.

Fort Campbell High School Softball Field (SBF) drainage repairs would be temporary in nature as the determination for a design in FY-15.

- Fill all low spots/areas that appear to be holding water with clean top soil.
- Use brick dust liberally as a supplement to the drying process.
- Use the current tarps on the infield when scheduled games and rain is forecasted.

Long Term:

-A project has been established within the DDESS Facilities forecasting program to establish a drainage design for the Fort Campbell High School Softball Field for FY-15; funding will be 20K.

- A project has been established within the DDESS Facilities forecasting program to establish a design for a Press box/storage/concession stand for FY-15; funding will be 75K. Construction for this project will be in FY-18; funding will be 650K.
- A project has been established within the DDESS Facilities forecasting program to develop a Master Plan design for all Fort Campbell Schools Sport Facilities for FY-15; funding will be 70K.

This will be a major effort to design and upgrade all existing sports complexes to current KHSAA/DDESS requirements and provide all our students with exceptional facilities to match their exceptional performance in high school athletics. As with all Government projects they subject to the availability of funds.

Accommodation of Interests and Abilities—

In the first part of February I had a student meeting to gauge the interest in starting bowling and/or archery. Attached you will find the sign-up sheets for both activities. The sign-up for bowling included 4 girls and 5 boys. The sign-up for archery included 6 girls and 10 boys. Even though that did not reach the number of girls needed to continue I advertised for a parent and student interest meeting that was held on April 21, 2014. The students were e-mailed, and the information was included on the schools website and well as the Principals e-mail that goes out dally. This information was put out for 10 days prior to the meeting. On the night of the meeting I had 3 parents and 4 students show up. The sign-up sheet for this meeting is included in the attachments. At this time I do not believe Fort Campbell High School has the support needed to add either bowling or archery as a new sport.

Support Services--

We have set up a new office for coaches per walk through with Mr. Lawson during our audit. The office is equipped with a computer, keyboard, printer and telephone. There are two file cabinets for the use of the sports as well as a storage closet. There is also a working bathroom in the office. A letter from Coach Moulden is attached. She was not able to come into the school to sign off on the memo of progress that is also attached.

Scheduling of Game and Practice Times --

I have attached the game schedules for both the boys baseball and girls softball games for this season. We added games to the softball schedule from the audit time as well as cancelled baseball games to keep us within correct numbers. I retyped the softball schedule since there were games that were cancelled that were already deleted from KHSAA in addition, there were games versus Tennessee teams that were not on the schedule.

Locker rooms, Practice and Competitive Facilities --

I have attached the memorandum from Mr. John Owens who is heading up the work on the plans for the softball fields.

Publicity --

As instructed, we have expanded the rules and explanations regarding athletic awards and post season banquets. The memo that has been added to our handbook is attached.

As per walk through during the December audit, I showed Mr. Lawson where I was planning on setting up a new coach's office due to the fact that the one official office was lacking in space and computers.


