#4 not at present have enough participants for a girls' jr team in basketball. If it is a district contest the squad must cheer for both teams. If at any time during the season it appears they will cheer for more boys' games than girls' adjustments are and will be made. Past years have shown that the girls' team has cheerleaders more than the boys' team.
