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## ATHLETICS POLICY AWAY BALLGAMES

- All athletes will be transported to away ballgames by bus. The driver will be arranged by the Athletic Director and the Director of Transportation. Athletes may ride home with their parents or legal guardians IF they are signed out by them at the game. Coaches will be responsible for the signing out of athletes.
  - All food stops during away ballgames will be paid for by the individual athletes. There will be an exception to this on overnight trips. On trips requiring overnight stay, athletes will stay at a hotel that provides continental breakfast. The school will be responsible for providing dinner for all student athletes.
  - Overnight trips that require lodging will be organized by the Athletic Director. The AD will be responsible for the booking of hotel rooms. Girls and Boys teams will stay at the same hotel on different floors when possible. If not possible separate hotels will be found. There will be a maximum of 4 students per room on overnight trips. The athletic director will be responsible for the provision of parity.
