3. Describe, in detail, the selection process for each named squad.

March, all students interested in being a cheerleader take a packet of information about the guidelines for the squad, tryout information, and requirements for being a cheerleader. Each candidate gives each of their teachers an evaluation form to complete about their grades and work ethic, the secretary fills out an attendance report, the attention supervisor completes a behavior report, and each candidate undergoes an interview. For the first four days of tryout week, candidates learn a chant, cheer, and dance that are taught by outgoing senior cheerleaders. On the fifth day, cheerleaders are assigned a number and go into the gym individually to perform the cheer and chant and in groups of four to perform the dance. Outside of school judges critique the candidates and score them. All criteria (grades, teacher evaluations, attendance, discipline, interview) are compiled and the top scores are the cheerleading squad. There will be no more than ten cheerleaders and the candidates with the highest scores are posted alphabetically on the school front door by 5:00 on the day of tryouts.
