Mr. Lawson,

At the end of the 2013-2014 school year, the Fulton Independent School district conducted a student interest survey to gauge the student body's interest in sports and activities not offered within the district. After the surveys were completed, there seemed to be enough interest in four specific sports and activities to conduct meetings to move forward with the possibility of starting new programs. The four sports/activities that students seemed interested in were Archery, Bass Fishing, Cross Country, and Track and Field.

Two meetings were held to gauge student and parent interest in moving forward with the sports and activities. On August 13, 2014 a student only meeting was held in the High School Computer Lab at Fulton City High School. Twelve students attended the meeting with some showing interest across sports/activities. On August 27, 2014 a student-parent meeting was held to further gather information about the genuine interest in starting the above mentioned sports/activities. Eight students and five parents attended the meeting, which was held in the High School Computer Lab. The findings from the meetings led us to believe there was not viable interest in the sports/activities. We will look to gather more information with the 2015-2016 student survey.
