Specifics of the procedure will be explained during tryout practice. As a group, the score sheets will go to the tabulator. A master score sheet will be tallied (each candidate will receive a blank copy of a score sheet before tryouts) A list of newly elected cheerleaders will be posted outside the school doors after tryouts have been completed.
