GCHS Travel Policy for Athletics

Athletic Trips All requests for transportation shall be approved by the principal and then approved by the transportation director. The coach may request a bus or 1 or 2 GCHS District Vans. Buses can transport up to 55 student athletes while the vans can only transport 7 students plus the driver. (A total of 8). The principal and transportation director will approve the mode of transportation. At no time should an athlete be allowed to drive a school related vehicle. Coaches must obtain the appropriate training from the transportation director in order to drive a district bus or van. Coaches may at NO time transport students to competitions or practices in their personal vehicles. If a coach decides to do so, they assume all liability.

Parents are to be informed of the nature of all trips, the approximate departure and return times, means of transportation, and any other relevant information. Athletic trips at the high school level shall include a meal(s) if the trip is overnight at the athletic departments expense. If the trip is after school, no meal will be provided. Schedules will indicate the location of home/away with the school's name so parents will know the location of the trip. Students are to be dropped off and picked up as close to the dining entrance as possible and supervised closely as they enter and exit. Athletes may not leave the site to which their bus was assigned without permission of the coach. The coach will then have written permission from the parent if the student is being taken by someone other than their custodial parent. The coach will use the district approved "check out" sheet which has been signed and approved by the parent, a witness and the school principal/designee. The person taking the students must be at least 21 years of age. The Superintendent shall submit for Board approval a listing of excursions designated as local trips. The Board shall consider on an individual basis requests for overnight trips out-of-state trips, a district employed coach shall accompany the group.

Lodging for overnight trips:

The coach, athletic director and principal will approve the hotel/motel/ in which the athletes will be housed. The lodging will be at the expense of the athletic department. All lodging will be booked by the principal or athletic director and they will be responsible for parity. There will be no more than 4 athletes assigned to each room.

1. Overnight trips must be approved by the athletic director and principal.
2. Each student-athlete (both male and female) on the trip will be allotted up to \$25 per day for food expenses. The team taking the trip must have the money in their individual account to cover the cost of food and lodging on the trip. The Athletic Department will also help offset the cost of meals on any state tournament trips up to \$400.
3. Lodging will be at a quality hotel for both male and female trips. Hotels should have indoor hallways and provide a continental breakfast when available.
4. The team taking an overnight trip will cover the cost of food and lodging for the bus driver as well.

5. The school will not pay for any meals for any athletic teams playing athletic contests that are not overnight trips.
6. Charter busses should only be used on any trip that is over 250 miles.
