I do not view this as a Title IX problem. The only way it might be considered one is if the baseball team has a freshman, JV and varsity team and because the softball team does not allow these players to move up they therefore cannot field a freshman, JV and varsity team and the high school is currently in the midst of having a problem with not offering enough athletic participation opportunities (based on the percent/ratio of enrollment for boys and girls at the school) for the female gender. If this athletic participation opportunities test is unmet in your annual report, this then could be a problem.
