4. How is each cheerleading squad assigned to home and away athletic contests? Include football as well as boys' and girls' basketball (and any other sport) at the varsity and junior varsity levels. Include any rotation plans or alternating game assignments that your squads follow.

The gold squad cheers for the varsity boys and the green squad cheers for the varsity girls basketball teams. Both teams cheer for the varsity football team. Games to be cheered during the basketball season include home games as well as away games that are district and regional rivals. In the event one squad is not available, the other squad will perform during big games.

Yes. Pep Band is requested for the same number of boys and girls games for district and regional opponents. The dance team is asked to dance on nights of district rivals and when boy/girl double headers are scheduled as a home event. We have also brought the middle school cheer squads and dance teams in to perform at the events that the high squads are not available. An equal number of sessions for both boys and girls are scheduled.
