Travel

Comment Submit to KHSAA an expansion of the current guidelines for travel and per diem which addresses equitable provision in regard to mode of transportation and lodging for student athletes. This expansion should become a part of the Title IX file.

Response Effective immediately the travel and per diem guidelines will reflect the lodging for teams will consist up to \$125.00 per room which will include a double bed per 4 athletes; a continental breakfast and a indoor meeting place for both male and female athletes. Meals will be \$15.00 a day per athlete and the mode of transportation will be a school bus in which the school will provide. See attached revised guidelines.

Publicity

Comment Submit to KHSAA an expansion of the current regulations for publicity which addresses equitable provision in relation to post season banquets. This expansion should become a part of the Title IX file.

Response Effective immediately the awards and recognition guidelines will reflect that each team's banquet will be conducted on school grounds and be potluck. Individual awards will cost \$15.00 per student athlete. See revised awards and recognition guidelines.

I. Travel and Per Diem Allowances

Jackson Independent School Athletics Department shall maintain an equitable policy to provide guidelines and procedures for the travel and per diem of student-athletes who participate in KHSAA sanctioned sports.

All athletic travel and per diem of student-athletes shall be governed by the following criteria:

- The athletic department will not provide money for the purchase of meals during the regular season.
- In the event that a team or individual makes the "state tournament" in their **sport** (does not include sport-activities), the Jackson City District's General Fund will purchase one meal per day during their stay at the contest. Meal money allocated for any sports team shall be \$15.00 per athlete/coach, per day. Individual players for individual sports (i.e. golf, cross country, or track) will receive an allocation of \$15.00 per athlete/coach as well.
- Meals purchased by Booster Clubs/teams for any team shall be \$15.00 per athlete/coach, per day.
- Hotel rooms for state tournament **sports** (does not include sport-activities) tournaments participation will be provided by the Jackson City School District's General Fund as follows: one double queen size bed room per every 4 athletes or coaches. The district does not provide lodging or meals for any persons other than players and board approved coaches.
- **Hotel rooms paid for by boosters/teams for athletes must equitably allocate the same amount for males and females. Cost of rooms up to \$125.00 a night for both male and female overnight trips.**
- **The motel/hotel accommodations: 1) double queen size bed per 4 athletes/coaches, 2) continental breakfast for all students/coaches, 3) indoors meeting area.**
- **The athletic dept. will equitably provide all transportation at the current Kentucky Dept. of Education rate for events for male and female sports. The mode of transportation shall be a school bus provided by the school.**
- Male and female **sports** (does not include sport-activities) shall be given equitable travel opportunities for regular season tournaments, post-season tournaments, out-of-region and out-of-state events. Each female and each male athletic team will be given the opportunity of participating in one out-of-state contest/tournament each four years. All out-of-state and/or over-night events must be approved by the Board of Education.

- Out-of-state trips must have the same equitable location for each team and/or program. For example, if the boys' baseball team wants to play in Florida, the girls' softball team must be given the same opportunity to play in Florida as well.
- Student-athletes shall ride the athletic bus/van to and from any and all scheduled events.
- All student-athletes traveling by bus to school sponsored sports events must return to the school on the same bus, unless parents/legal guardians have submitted a travel waiver and had it approved prior to the scheduled trip (a new waiver must be submitted and approved for each individual trip). If a travel waiver has been submitted and approved, the parent/guardian must see the head coach and sign their child out before they leave with them.
- Student-athletes may not be released to ride with any person other than their own parent or legal guardian unless approved in writing by the parents, administration, and coach in advance.
- Student-athletes with extenuating circumstances may request approval in writing for another means of transportation, by the coach, principal, or athletic director.

P. Awards and Recognition Guidelines

- Any sports team that wins a District Championship; wins or makes it to a Regional Semi or Final Game, wins a game at state level competition, or state winner/runner-up will be recognize with a banner being hung.
- Any individual recommended by the Jackson City Board of Education, Superintendent, Principal and Athletic Director for recognition could be recognized for their achievement.
- Senior Night awards will be given on the last home game for that individual. The awards cost will be a maximum of \$15.00 per award for both male and female athletes. The funds will come from each individual teams' account.
- Any athlete who reaches milestones in their sport will be recognized. The award will need to be of equal value for all athletes in similar sports.
- **Each team will conduct a team banquet at the end of their season. The banquet will consist of a pot-luck and be held on school grounds.**
- **Individual awards at banquets will cost \$15.00 per athlete for both males and females.**
