





Boys and Girls Soccer: Each has their own locker room and storage space at the LCCHS Soccer Field.

Boys and Girls Tennis: The only equipment the Tennis Team has is Tennis Balls and a Ball Machine and the coach keeps those with him.

Boys and Girls Basketball: Each has their own storage space in their respective office and locker room.

Volleyball: Has their own storage space in the volleyball coach's office.

Football: Has their own storage space in the football office and locker room.

Boys and Girls Golf: The Golf Coach, who is the pro at Raven Rock Golf Course, stores balls and extra clubs in his office at the golf course.

#### ATHLETIC SPENDING SUMMARY

Football is the sport with the most expenditures without a "like team". We have addressed this with our coach and will reduce his budget for 2012-13 school year.

2011-12 Title IX Report will show disparity in travel for Boys Basketball (\$20916) and Girls Basketball (\$10091) as both teams traveled to Florida during Christmas break during the 2011-12 Basketball season. The boys team paid for their trip before the end of the 2010-11 school year. The girls team paid for their trip in the fall of the 2011-12 school year and will be reflected on the 2012-13 Title IX Report using 2011-12 school year financial report. (Girls spent \$23,000 on their trip).

Letcher County Central High School will show that boys expenditures were 61% (5% decrease) and girls expenditures were 39% (5% increase) for the 2010-11 school year and will be reflected on this years, 2011-12, Title IX Report.

If the above changes do not bring spending within acceptable parameters the school will continue to address this issue through corrective action.

#### PLAN FOR TRAVEL AND PER DIEM 2012-13 SCHOOL YEAR

Travel, lodging and food will be paid for by the Letcher County Central High School Athletic Team. Under no circumstances are student athletes to pay for any of the above.

A maximum of \$10.00 per meal will be allowed per student. Maximum may be raised with prior approval of the Principal or the Athletic Director.

A maximum of \$100.00 per room per night will be allocated for lodging for the athletic teams at Letcher County Central High School. (norm is to place 4 athletes per room)

#### **BEGINNING 2012-2013 SCHOOL YEAR**
