The pep band performs at all home boys and girls varsity basketball games on an equal basis. The pep band performs for boys and girls varsity basketball games at the district and regional tournaments.

Tryouts

LCHS will hold tryouts for the selection of the cheerleading squad. Tryout dates will be no earlier than April 1st and will NOT conflict with CATS testing.

The cheerleading sponsor(s) will be responsible for the preparation and distribution of a packet of information available to all candidates. This information will include specific tryout dates, times, attire, and procedures. Before a student is eligible to participate in tryouts, the candidate and his/her parent must sign a form stating that understand and will comply with all information in the packet including, but not limited to: rules, responsibilities, and consequences. Anyone wishing to tryout must file an application and all other required forms by the first day of clinic. Attendance of every clinic day is **MANDATORY**, except for extenuating circumstances and 1 permissible written doctor's excuse. If a doctor's excuse is obtained, written release to tryout is also necessary from the same physician. On the day of tryouts, the candidate must wear a plain T-shirt (no visible logo), solid colored shorts, and clean athletic shoes.

Selection

Panel tryouts (in front of judges) will be **CLOSED** to everyone except, judges, sponsors, and graduating-senior cheerleaders. There will not be students, parents, or unauthorized persons in the tryout room, nor will they be involved in the collection and tabulation of scores. **ALL TRYOUT RESULTS ARE FINAL.** The number of candidates selected to be apart of the squad will vary depending on the number of participants with the proper qualifications. Of the candidates chosen to make up the cheerleading squad, those chosen to participate in competition will be determined based on skill, need, attitude, and performance.

Judging Criteria

Females trying out will be judged on the following:

- Jumps
- Tumbling
- Cheer/Motions
- Chant
- Dance
- Spirit/Voice
- Overall Impression

Males trying out will be judged on the following:

- Jumps
- Tumbling (must be willing to attempt and improve)
- Stunts (base, back-spot, front-spot, cradle, flick, etc.)
- Spirit/Voice
- Overall Impression
