
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# Lewis County High School Travel Guidelines

- Teams travelling overnight or a distance of two hours or more that would require the team to purchase a meal will receive the amount of \$10 per team member per meal for lunch and/or dinner. If a breakfast is required, each member would receive \$5 per meal. The daily per diem amount cannot exceed \$25. The cost will be covered by the activity fund for each individual team.
- Teams travelling overnight are encouraged to find a destination that serves breakfast as part of their lodging cost, if this is not available, then the \$5 per diem would apply for this meal.
- Lodging expenses for travelling overnight should not exceed \$125 per room per night, unless the lodging is a single source or only available option. Teams are encouraged to find package deals when travelling to tournaments that include lodging as a tournament perk.
- Travel to and from contests will be on a board owned, certified school bus. The athletic teams do not use charter buses.

### Response to Checklist of the Title IX components

- 1. Equipment and supplies.
  - Enclosed is a copy of the revised expanded cycle of uniform replacement for all teams. The cycle now contains Boys/ Girls Golf and Boys/girls tennis as annual replacement.
- 2. Travel and Per Diem Allowances
  - The school guidelines are clarified to indicate the only mode of transportation used by any boy/girl sport is locally owned school buses. The district will not use charter buses as a means of transportation.

#### KHSAA recommended Action in relation to new deficiencies

- 1. Scoreboard— A new scoreboard has already been ordered and received. It will be installed for use this year. Completion date: 2016 Season
- 2. Press box— The current press box will be remodeled with upgrades to paint and flooring. Completion date: 2017 Season
- 3. Office space— An office space will be provided of equitable size for the girls softball coach in close proximity to the softball field. Completion date: 2017 Season
- 4. Cover chair back seating— The school will begin researching options for chairback and covered seating. Completion date: 2020 Season
