Athletic Travel and Per Diem

1. All athletic travel must be approved by the Principal and/or Superintendent/Board of Education pursuant to Board Policy 09.36.
2. All travel must satisfy Title IX regulations
3. All hotels must be approved by administration (principal, assistant principal, athletic director, or designee). The price per night shall not be less than \$75 but no more than \$125. The fore mentioned amounts may be adjusted by administrative discretion based on factors beyond our control. All hotels will have doors that open to the interior of the building. If at any point a hotel with interior rooms is not available, administration will have discretion to approve other lodging types.
4. Students and staff will be allowed a per diem amount for food while on the athletic trip. Students will be allowed \$20 per day and staff \$35 per day.
5. Students will be transported by district owned vehicle whenever possible. Currently the district has Suburbans and buses available. The mode of transportation will follow district policy and must be approved by administration. Transportation by Suburban will occur when there are 14 or less students traveling. In the instance where there are 15 or more students, a bus must be taken.

SchoolRelated Student Trips**CERTIFICATED COMMON CARRIERS**

Use of certificated common carrier service shall be authorized by the Board on a casebycase basis, and the reasons to justify such use shall be cited in Board minutes.³

REQUESTS FOR APPROVAL

Written requests for approval of trips must be submitted to the Principal five (5) school days in advance of the trip date. The Principal shall schedule the use of Districtowned vehicles for the trip.

REIMBURSEMENT

The group or organization using a school vehicle shall bear the cost of the trip and shall reimburse the Board for the bus driver's salary, including waiting time for day trips; food; lodging; and per mileage costs. Waiting time shall not be paid for overnight trips.

FEES

Students may be charged for transportation and admission for cultural enrichment programs or extracurricular activities when the field trip is voluntary, is authorized by the Board and approved by the Superintendent, and is not an athletic activity or event. Funds are provided by the Board to pay for those students who could not otherwise participate.

MEDICATION

Administration of medication to students during field trips shall comply with applicable law, regulation and medication administration training developed by the Kentucky Department of Education.

When students will be travelling outside the state, the Superintendent's designee shall do the following:

1. Determine applicable legal requirements concerning delegation of student medication responsibilities in states through which students will be travelling; and
2. Assign staff to accompany students on the field trip to address student medication needs.

PARENTS' APPROVAL

Parents are to be informed of the nature of the trip, the approximate departure and return times, means of transportation, and any other relevant information. Parents must give written approval for students to participate in schoolsponsored trips.

School-Related Student Trips

EXTENSION OF CLASSROOM WORK

The Board encourages school-related trips that are of educational value. Such trips are to be an extension of the regular classroom work and an integral part of the educational program. School trips shall be for instructional or performance purposes only.

In order for students to be counted present during school-related trips during the school day, the activity must be co-curricular or instructional.

PRINCIPAL TO APPROVE

The school Principal shall have the authority to give prior approval to school-related trips which fall into the following categories:

1. All regularly scheduled athletic events;
2. All athletic trips which are part of a tournament or playoff in which the school is a participant; and
3. All school-related trips made within a 150 mile radius of the school, except for out-of-state trips, which must be approved by the Superintendent or authorized by the Board.

BOARD REGULARLY INFORMED

The Board shall be regularly informed of any trip falling within these guidelines.

DRIVERS/VEHICLES

All District-owned vehicles shall be driven by an adult duly qualified and licensed to operate the vehicle. Drivers of school vehicles and operation of District-owned passenger vehicles transporting students shall be in compliance with requirements specified in applicable statutes and administrative regulations.¹

SUPERVISION

A certified or classified staff member must accompany students on all school-sponsored or school-endorsed trips. For athletic trips, a nonfaculty coach or a nonfaculty assistant may accompany students as provided in statute. Persons designated to accompany students shall be at least twenty-one (21) years old.²

INSURANCE

Only Board insured vehicles or appropriately certificated common carriers shall be used for transporting students.³

PRIOR APPROVAL FOR OTHER TRIPS

Any school-related trips not falling within the guidelines above shall require prior Board approval.
