Athletic Uniform Review Policy

The Lyon County Board of Education, in conjunction with sport-specific booster clubs via a signed booster club agreement, will provide an athletic competition uniform to all students of athletic teams including basketball, soccer, baseball, and softball. Uniforms will be provided as determined by the Principal and Athletic Director, and will become the property of the Lyon County Board of Education. All athletic uniforms will be distributed by the team coach, under the direction of the Athletic Director, at the beginning of each sport season. Uniforms must be returned by the student athletes at the close of each sport season or as dictated by the Athletic Director. Uniforms returned by student athletes that are deemed unacceptable, or that are lost or stolen, will be subject to a replacement fee for the cost of the uniform.

All athletic teams wherein uniforms are not provided by the school, including tennis, track, golf, and cross country, track, and cheerleading, will be provided by the student athletes. Uniforms may be provided via the use of fundraising profits per the Lyon County Board of Education's fundraising policy. Individual team coaches will provide a detailed outline of these requirements to each student athlete after approved by the Athletic Director. Uniforms for middle school athletics will be exempt from this policy.

All athletic teams will observe the following uniform cycle beginning on August 1, 2011, the purpose being to fulfill requirements mandated by the Kentucky High School Athletic Association (KHSAA) for a written uniform policy, as well as satisfy the Benefits Provision of Title IX. All uniforms, those provided by the Lyon County Board of Education and provided by athletes, must meet the uniform requirements of the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS), as mandated by the KHSAA.

Review for Uniforms Provided by the Lyon County Athletic Department (Review after Year 4). A total of \$2,000.00 per team will be allowed and the Boosters has the right to supplement the remaining amount.

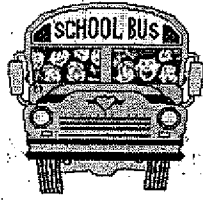

Athletic Travel Policy

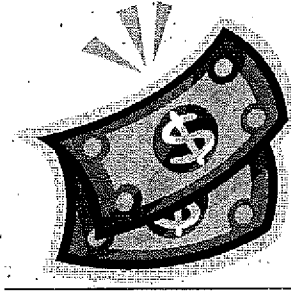
All athletic travel must have approval of the Lyon County Central Office. All overnight travel along with travel out of the state of Kentucky must have the approval of the Lyon County Board of Education. In cases of participation outside of the state of Kentucky, the athletic director is required to make certain that the event is sanctioned, as mandated by the KHSAA.

Any mode of transportation to be used for school athletic events other than district-owned school busses or vehicles, must receive prior approval from the Lyon County Board of Education.

Any student athlete or team that is to compete at the State Level will be transported by Lyon County Board of Education approved vehicles, either bus or suburban.

The Board of Education provides transportation for athletic events at a cost of .50 per mile to the athletic department for regular season contest and post season play. All other trips must be paid for from the athletic team. At the present time the Lyon County Board of Education absorbs the cost of school vehicles for regular season and post season play.

Athletic Per Diem Policy

All per diem allowances for student-athletes must follow the guidelines listed below:

- Breakfast: \$5.00 ✓
- Lunch: \$10.00 ✓
- Dinner: \$15.00 ✓

Per diem allowances requested for regular season competition, sanctioned KHSAA post-season district level competition, or non-sanctioned KHSAA sporting events will be provided by the sport-specific booster club. All per diem allowances for sanctioned KHSAA post-season regional, sectional, and state level competition will be provided by the Lyon County Athletic Department. Lyon County High School and the Lyon County Athletic Department are not responsible for reimbursement to the booster clubs when purchasing/providing meals during regular season or sanctioned KHSAA post-season district competition. The booster clubs must still follow the above-stated guidelines. The allotment of \$30.00 per diem per student-athlete must never be exceeded in any circumstance.

All receipts must be returned with the appropriate travel request form upon return to school in a timely manner for reimbursements to be processed.

The Principal or Athletic Director will be responsible for reserving hotel rooms for the teams. An allowance of \$100.00-\$120.00 per room will be allowed for both genders. Hotel allowances will be granted by the Athletic Director during the regular season or sanctioned KHSAA In-season, post-season, district, sectional, or regional play. The particular sport's budget will be responsible for hotel accommodations for any Fall Break, Christmas, or Spring Break tournaments. The booster clubs may assist the payment in the case that the sports team doesn't have sufficient funds.

If a student athlete stays with a parent at an event and the school has provided a room there will be no payment to the parent's room. If an athlete is going with the parent and the parent is the chaperone the athletic budget of that sport is responsible for paying half or up to \$50.00 per night for the nights of KHSAA sanctioned state competition.

The principal or athletic director reserves the right to suspend the team's right or booster club's right to purchase meals if the above stated guidelines are not met, or gender inequity is in question, as mandated by Title IX policy.

Baseball

- This storage space is shared between the softball and baseball teams. When entering the gymnasium through the front entry doors, the Lyon County Baseball storage space will be located at the stage end of the gym, in the left hallway, located directly across from the Lyon County Lyons Basketball locker room.

Track

The Lyon County Track teams have storage space located in the middle school equipment room.

Cross Country

The Lyon County Cross Country teams have storage space located in the middle school equipment room

Lee S. Jones Park

Soccer

-Both teams share the space with golf on the right side of the stage in the high school and have storage space located in the storage buildings at both ends of the soccer field, closest to the bleachers. There is additional storage for both teams located in the soccer concession stand.

Other Storage Areas

Tennis

-The Lyon County Tennis team has storage located in the Lyon County Middle School. Doors to the storage room face the courts. The primary storage space is located in the ice room at the old middle school across from the weight room.

Golf

-The Lyon County Golf team uses the storage room on the right of the stage at the high school to store golf bags. All other equipment is the responsibility of the athlete.
