Murray High School Travel Policy

All athletic trips must receive prior approval through submission of a travel request to the Murray High School Principal. Overnight and out-of-state trips require School Board approval while all other trips require Principal and Superintendent approval. Trips that exceed 200 miles using a school bus will result in teams being billed for the excess mileage over 200 miles. All athletic trips must use school approved transportation. Any mode of transportation to be used for school athletic events other than district owned vehicles must receive approval of the AD, Principal and Superintendent. In special cases where teams have to travel more than 150 miles one way such as state tournaments, etc., every effort will be made by the school administration to fund a charter bus for safety purposes.

Athletic Per Diem

Per diem allowance for meals is not allowed for regular season play unless a tournament where teams will be staying for an extended period or overnight. Any per diem allowance for tournament or overnight must be approved in advance by the Athletic Director.

Per diem allowances for athletic participants during post-season and tournament play shall follow the guidelines listed:

Breakfast \$5: Lunch \$10 Dinner \$15

Booster clubs must follow the above related guidelines when purchasing/providing meals during tournaments and post season. The total allotment of \$30 shall not be exceeded.

Lodging will only be provided for tournament and post season play where traveling back and forth is not feasible. Competition occurring within 100 miles requires teams to travel back and forth. Any lodging request must be included in the travel request submitted to the Principal and must be approved by the Superintendent and School Board.

Lodging Requirements: Unless assigned by the tournament organizer, coaches will work with the AD to provide lodging that meets specific requirement. Every effort will be made to meet the following requirements. Student athletes will be housed 4 per room in a facility that does not have outside entrances to rooms for safety purposes. Every effort should be made to keep room costs to \$100-\$120 per room maximum while keeping the safety of students in the forefront during the selection process.

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Athletic Awards/Banquet Policy

Murray High School

The athletic programs at Murray High School will recognize the achievement of all student athletes in KHSAA recognized sports. An appropriate event will be held to recognize their achievements utilizing postposition of the school in the school district. Refreshments are to be provided by parents got a desert reception prior to the program.

A lettering policy is established for each sport and letter jackets/chevrons will be given to all students earning a varsity letter as determined by the lettering policy. In addition, captain bars will be issued to those students designated as captains.

Academic All State certificates will be distributed to those student athletes meeting Academic All State requirements as designated by the KHSAA,

Additional awards may be purchased by the team booster club to honor specific achievements within the sport. In order for these awards to be given, they must be on file with the Athletic Director and cost approved in advance by either the Athletic Director or Principal prior to the banquet. Awards must be limited to a cost of \$15 or less for each award given. The only exception, which must be approved in advance and on file with the AD, is an award in honor of a former athlete that has passed away and funds provided by the Mürray Schools Foundation.
