The sponsor/coach does not judge the tryouts. The judges are other people either from the school or outside of the school that have some knowledge of cheering.
4. How is each cheerleading squad assigned to home and away athletic contests? Include football as well as boys' and girls' basketball (and any other sport) at the varsity and junior varsity levels. Include any rotation plans or alternating game assignments that your squads follow. For this school year, the cheerleaders attend all football games, both home and away. During basketball season the cheerleaders cheer at all district games for both home and away. All of our district games are boy/girl doubleheaders. The cheerleaders cheer at all home games and choose other away games that are close by. The coach is very careful to cheer the same number of boys and girls games.
