Procedures for Band/Cheer/Dance Performances at Athletic Events

Band

Marching band will perform at all scheduled home varsity football contests. (Generally five regular season games and possible playoff games). The marching band will perform at any neutral site games (bowl, playoff) pending the approval of the host. The expense of transportation to any away contest will be covered by the athletic department.

The pep band will play at all home V/V double header basketball games. In addition, the band director will select two boys games and two girls game each season in which to play. These selections will be approved by the athletic director. The band may choose to play at additional games provided they play an equal number of boys and girls games or play all of the home contests in the event the boys and girls schedules are not exactly equal.

The band will play at the Championship Round of the district basketball tournament as well as all regional and state games provided bands are invited by the host. Should buses be required by the band the cost will be covered by the athletic department.

Special considerations will be made for band performance based on factors beyond our control including, but not limited to, school breaks, weather, and band performances (all district, etc).

Cheer

The cheerleaders are expected to perform at all home and away varsity football games. They are also expected to perform at all varsity basketball home games and away district games. This includes all boys and girls games.

The cheerleaders are expected to perform at all postseason contests for both boys and girls. In the event the teams play in a regular season tournament the cheerleaders are expected to attend any games scheduled for a start between 5PM and 8PM.

Special considerations will be made for cheer performance based on factors beyond our control including, but not limited to, school breaks, weather, and cheer competitions.
