Athletic policy for displaying jerseys and banners

- 1. Any athlete who makes 1st Team All State in their sport is eligible to have a jersey or banner displayed at the sport facility.
- 2. Any player who sets a school record for a major stat. category or makes an All State list will be eligible to be considered for displaying their jersey/banner. A committee made up of the Principal, the AD, an Assistant Principal and a boys and girls head coach will decide based on the merit of the player/team. 4 of the 5 votes must be yes votes.
- 3. Any athlete who is named Mr. or Mrs. will have their own banner displayed.
- 4. Any athlete who wins National Player of the Year will have their number retired. No other numbers will be retired.
- 5. If a former athlete is convicted of a serious crime their banner/jersey may be removed.
- 6. State Championship banners will be purchased by the Athletic Department and hung in the back entrance to the school.
- 7. Region and State winners will have a sticker with the year placed upon the sports banner in the gym.
- 8. All jerseys that are currently hanging in the gym will be "grandfathered" to this policy.
- 9. Athletic Hall of Fame has a selection committee and accepts nomination until May 1st of each year. Those inducted are invited to a dinner and are recognized at a home football game. Each selectee are given a plaque.
