To Whom It May Concern:

After our recent Title IX audit, an issue still remains about the construction on the new athletic fields for Phelps High School. I want to emphasize that the field construction process is under the control of the Pike County Board of Education...not anyone at Phelps High School. I agree that the project is long past due; however, various issues/agencies have slowed the process tremendously. Below is a bullet list of what is known about the new field construction:

- The new Phelps Elementary School is nearing completion and students will be in the school in August 2013
- Construction can't begin until students and staff are off the old Phelps Elementary site
- Several pieces of property have been acquired by the PCBOE next to the old Phelps Elementary site
- Meetings have taken place with the Kentucky Department of Transportation for entrance/exit locations
- Architect provided several rough drafts of potential field layouts
- PCBOE has narrowed the rough drafts with two possible layouts being considered
- Additional land acquisition necessary after reviewing the two field layouts
- PCBOE tawyer Neil Smith met with additional landowners for property acquisition
- Mineral rights issue brings the new property acquisition to a standstill...ahundance of red tape
- January 2013 meeting with KDE, Neil Smith, architect and mineral rights owner to clear red tape
- Mr. Johnson (PCBOE project manager) met with the Kentucky School Board on February 6, 2013
- · After meeting with KSB, the project was approved...awaiting official document of approval
- The next step is to meet with the Army Corps and Kentucky Division of Water for a construction release
- Once the construction release is in hand, new land acquisition deeds are awaiting signatures from landowners
- If no other red tape issues spring up, construction should begin with the end of school in May 2013

In regards to our recent Title IX visit and the issue of a boosters club at Phelps High School. Phelps High School does not have a buoster's club organization. I became principal at PHS six years ago and any resemblance of a boosters club ended when I became principal. While working as the PHS Athletic Director, I found the boosters club to be a constant source of problems, therefore, I ended the club once I became principal. I feel that some confusion exists about a group of parents that work to help our Junior High programs at PHS. Being a 7-12 school, we do have parents that do things for our Junior High sports programs...not ANY high school program.

An issue specifically dealing with shoes being purchased was addressed on our recent audit. The shoes were purchased for the Junior High Girls Basketball players only...not high school. The Girl's Varsity Basketball shoes were purchased with a school purchase order with money that was generated by the Girl's Varsity Basketball program. No outside funding source was/has been used to purchase high school athletic needs.
