### Trophies, Banquets, Pictures, Honors Policy

Pikeville High School Booster Clubs will have a Fall, Winter, Spring Sports Banquet for the athletes that play during these seasons. All Athletes that have participated on these Teams will be honored. Coaches of these sports will be able to give out trophies or awards to their athletes paid by their respective Booster Club. The Athletic Department and the Booster Clubs will be responsible for paying each half of an athletes' letterman jacket, they become eligible to receive one in their Sophomore year and have to letter in a sport 2 years to receive a letterman jacket. These will be given out during an assembly in May before school is out to all letterman that will receive a jacket each year.

The school will place pictures of any State Championship Team in the middle of the commons area paid for by the school.

Awards given by the Athletic Department, (Stephen R. Flanary) recipient can be Male and or Female, have a 3.5 GPA or higher, looked up to by team mates, outstanding character, leader on and off the floor. Have to play 3 sports in the same year, (Fall, Winter, Spring). The plaque hangs in the commons area.

Trophies are placed in a Gender Equity friendly manner to display Female Championships as well as Male Championships, District, Region, and State Awards.

#### 1,000 Point Club

Males and Females in the sport of Baskethall will have a plaque outside of their respective locker room with their name, jersey number and total points scored and the years played.

## Travel and Per Diem

All Teams will be allowed to Travel within a reasonable area as long as instructional time is not missed to travel to contests. The Board of Education pays the first \$10,000 of money spent on Travel, after that is expended, the Athletic Department picks up the rest of Travel expenses. The Boys and Girls teams will be allowed to travel by charter bus on lengthy trips,(at the expense of their respective booster clubs) school buses will be used for other trips, and housing allowance up to \$125.00 per room per night.

Student/Athletes will receive \$7.50 for Breakfast, \$7.50 for Lunch, \$15.00 for Dinner. This is an increase of \$10.00 from our previous policy.
