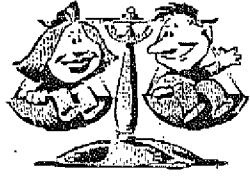

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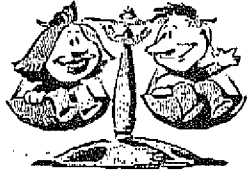

Since you report expenditures for the prior year, I am requesting that those be available for your schools first Gender Equity Review Committee meeting in the fall. At that meeting your committee should review the expenditures and determine whether you still have an inequity in spending. If an inequity exists, your committee should then develop a plan to address this problem.
