


Team Banquet and Awards Policy

Each team will be required to hold and end of the year banquet. Each individual sport will pay for their own banquet. Coaches are expected to serve a dinner with their banquet. Each sport is permitted to spend between \$12 and \$20 per athlete between dinner and awards at the banquet.

Each sports team will purchase their trophies that will be presented at the banquet. It is at the discretion of the head coach on how he/she awards the trophies/plaques.

Travel and Per Diem Allowances

Policy:

The Larry A. Ryle High School Athletic Department shall maintain an equitable policy to provide guidelines and procedures for the travel and per diem of student-athletes.

Policy Statement:

All Athletic travel and per diem of student athletes shall be governed by the following criteria:

- Meal money allocated for any team shall be \$20.00 per athlete/per day. Coaches should only consider hotels that contain a free continental breakfast. Coaches should put 4 athletes to a room and hotel costs should not exceed \$130 per night.
- Male and Female sports shall be given equitable travel opportunities for regular season games and tournaments, post-season tournaments etc. All athletic teams have the option to take buses to any away contest. However, each sports team/organization must budget transportation costs/food and Lodging accordingly for their respective program. The Athletic Department will fund transportation costs/food/lodging for the state tournament. If teams choose not to use buses, then private transportation is used.
- Overnight/Out of state trips must be approved by the principal, superintendent and or Board of Education. A field trip request form must be filled out by head coach and submitted to the principal.
- Any program that wishes to utilize a Common Carrier Transportation Service (Charter Bus) must get prior approval from the Board of Education. A field trip request form must be filled out by the head coach and signed by the principal. Also, the Boone County Board of Education must approve the field trip. This request should be submitted to the Superintendent's office by noon at least (11) working days prior to next board meeting. Board meetings are held the second Thursday of the month.

A Charter Bus can only be utilized if the team/organization has at least 25 students and is traveling equal or more than 130 miles round trip.

- If buses are utilized for athletic events, all student-athletes shall ride the bus to the scheduled event. All student-athletes travelling by bus to school sponsored activities must return to the school on the same bus unless the parent or legal guardian personally addresses the coach or other supervisory school authority and takes custody of their child. The coach must get a written note and signature for this to happen.
- Private transportation to athletic contests can only be used if the following guidelines are met- an auto insurance affidavit must be on file with coach and central office verifying the required insurance coverage, under no circumstance can a student transport another student to a game.
