Tryouts were held in April 2005. Outside judges were brought in. Girls were judged on gymnastics, stunts, cheers, dance, and teacher recommendations. Scores were tallied by the coaches to determine who would be on the squad. A cut off score was determined according to the point spread of all the scores. Those scoring above the breakpoint made the squad.

4. How is each cheerleading squad assigned to home and away athletic contests? Include football as well as boys' and girls' basketball (and any other sport) at the varsity and junior varsity levels. Include any rotation plans or alternating game assignments that your squads follow.

Squad attends all home and away football games. Squad attends all home games for girls and boys basketball, and 90% of all away games for boys and girls basketball.
