
Dear Ms. McCarty,

This letter is a follow up letter to give you an update on the most recent "Title IX" project at Shawnee High School. 3 years ago Shawnee High School and KHSAA decided that the girls' locker room badly needed a face lift. While the square footage of the locker was more than sufficient, the use of the space was terrible. It was decided that the best use of space would be to take out 2/3's of the showers, and use that space as a team meeting space. Picture #1 shows a view of the new meeting space. As of today, the following changes have been made to the girl's locker room...

- Old 'rusty' gold color lockers removed along the wall across from the coaches room(#2)
- New dark blue lockers purchased and installed along this wall(#3)
- Old "rusty" golden lockers in corner and next to showers removed (#4)
- Navy lockers from the district warehouse installed on 2 walls (#5)
- Old gold lockers next to bathroom removed. Showers next to lockers removed (6)
- Floor filled in where showers were. Floor painted dark blue (7)
- Old ceiling tiles removed (#8)
- New ceiling tiles installed (#9)
- Old fixtures in bathroom repaired (#10)
- New fixtures in bathroom installed (#11)
- Old lockers between showers, and showers removed (#12)
- Showers had no curtains, mats, trash cans, etc. (#13)
- Dressing room and shower curtains were installed to all areas (#14)
- Dressing rooms and showers have bath mats and trash cans (#15)
- Shower accessories added (#16)

I have enclosed the corresponding pictures. I have also put together a list of items that still need to be done to complete this project. I am giving this list with pictures to the administrators. My hopes are to have the items on this list completed by basketball season. I have enclosed a copy of this list. We are very excited with how this project turned out, and look forward to projects in the future at Shawnee High School. Thank you for all your help.

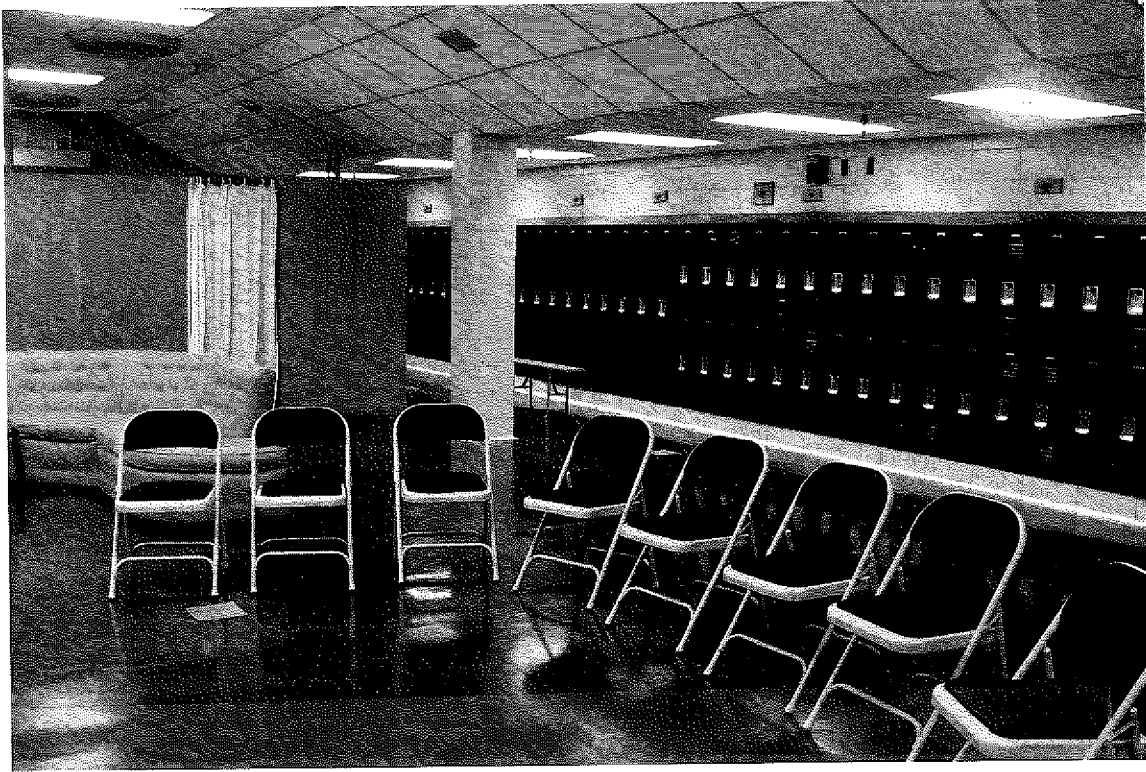
