AWARDS, RECOGNITION, TEAM BANNER POLICY

Retiring of Jersey:

1. Nominees must be members of South Laurel Hall of Fame.
2. Nominees must be out of high school for 10 years before he/she can be nominated.
3. All nominations must go through the GERC.
4. Unanimous vote by the committee is required.

Retiring of Mr. and Miss Kentucky Jersey:

1. Nominees must be out of high school for 5 years before he/she can be nominated.
2. All nominations must go through the GERC.
3. Unanimous vote by the committee is required.

Hanging of Team Banners:

1. Team must be KHSAA Regional Champion.
2. Banner will state Year, Sport/Sport Activity, and Level/Round Achieved.
3. The following teams will have a banner recognizing their achievement hung in the Gymnasium:
 - a. Girls Basketball
 - b. Boys Basketball
 - c. Volleyball
 - d. Competitive Cheer
4. The following teams will have their banners hung in the Trophy Case Hallway, and will only have one banner listing the level/round achieved followed by year.
 - a. Golf
 - b. Swim
 - c. Archery
 - d. Bass Fishing
5. Other Sports (Football, Baseball, Softball, Tennis, Soccer, Track, and Cross Country) will have their banners at their facilities.
6. In individual sports, the individual must be State Champion to have an individual banner recognizing achievement.

Team Awards / Varsity Letters and Bars:

1. Team awards / varsity letters and bars are at the discretion of the Head Coach and must be purchased from team activity/booster club accounts.

End of Season Recognitions:

1. Each team is required to conduct some form of recognition to conclude the season (ex. Banquet, potluck, cookouts, etc.)
