

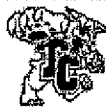

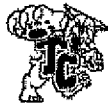

Travel and Per Diem Allowances:

Meals & Lodging

Per Diem allowances for athletic participants during regular season, district, regional and post-season play shall not exceed the guidelines listed below:

Breakfast- \$5.00

Lunch- \$10.00

Dinner \$15.00

If it is a sport in which reimbursement is made to the school by the KHSAA, booster organizations will be responsible for any amounts over and above the amount allotted to the school per meal by the KHSAA. Booster clubs must follow the above-stated guidelines when purchasing/providing meals during regular season and district/regional play, with knowledge that the school is not responsible for reimbursement to the boosters. Regardless of reimbursement or not, the total of \$30.00 per diem per athlete shall not be exceeded.

Lodging allowances will not be granted during regular season, district, or regional play.

If it is a sport in which reimbursement is made by the KHSAA for participation in state level play, booster organizations will reimburse the school for any amounts over and above the amounts provided by the KHSAA not to exceed the state rate allowance provided by the hotel.

The principal or athletic director reserves the right to suspend any team's right or booster club's right to purchase meals or select lodging if the above stated guidelines are not met, or a large inequity between male sports and female sports begins to become evident.

Travel

If more than ten (10) students are planning to go on a trip, then arrangements must be made to transport by bus. When a bus is used to transport students to an athletic event a copy of the seating chart must be turned in to the front office prior to departure.

Private vehicles may be used to transport students on school-related trips, provided such vehicles are fully insured and are to be operated by a licensed driver.

Before students are transported on school-related trips in private vehicles:

1. Group sponsors shall obtain the prior approval of the Superintendent or designee;
2. Parents of the students shall be notified that their children are to be transported in private vehicles; and;
3. Drivers of private vehicles shall be notified that their insurance will provide primary liability coverage in case of an accident (09.36)

Requests for transport on charter vehicles must be submitted for review and approved by the Board of Education.

Response to 2013-2014 Title IX Audit

Deficiency	Actions
<i>Drainage problems at softball field</i>	Drainage has been corrected. 22-24 tons of Marr Mix were purchased and placed on the surface during the first week of October 2013. Because the field is leased from the county for school use, county officials approved funding for the soil while a softball booster used a laser to ensure proper grading of the surface.

Deficiency	Actions
<i>Softball Locker Room</i>	In January of this year, Trigg County Public Schools central office personnel and TCHS administration met with our County Judge Executive to discuss facility needs cited in the Title IX audit. A commitment was made by both parties to ensure that facilities were made equitable. To date, a contractor has been selected and work has begun on the facility. The Trigg County Board of Education is partnered with the county to fund a female dressing room equipped with lockers that will ensure equitable facilities for softball. Upgrades to facilities will be completed in stages. Weather permitting; the structure will be operable by mid-March 2014. Full upgrades are on track to be complete by May 2014. Photographs included in this response indicate progress to this facility, additional photographs will be sent to KHSAA upon completion for verification.
