Each sport shall have a post-season banquet. Banquets should be scheduled considering the following guidelines.

1. Recognize Academic All-State 1<sup>st</sup> team (3.75) and Honorable Mention (3.25) student-athletes.
2. Recognize any All-District or All-Region athletes.

## Warren County Public Schools

### Student Travel Guidelines

When traveling to events the following guidelines should be used. The guidelines are for all boys and girls and apply whether the funds are paid for by Board / School funds or Athletic / Band booster funds.

#### **Meal Allowances:**

Each student (boys and girls) will be provided up to \$25.00 per day for meals.

#### **Room Allowances:**

Each student (boys and girls) will be allowed up to \$37.50 per day for rooms a maximum of 4 persons per room.

#### **Charter Busses:**

Each sport may opt to take a charter bus at the expense of the booster club using these guidelines:

1. The one-way trip mileage for the event exceeds 70 miles.

OR

2. Allocated travel funds have been exhausted or budgeted for other trips i.e. scheduled Freshman/JV games
