

Wayne County High School Athletic Awards and Banquets Guidelines

Awards Banquet

- All sports awards banquets for student-athletes of Wayne County HS shall occur on the campus of Wayne County Schools. If a sport desires to hold their banquet in another location, they must receive approval from either the principal of Wayne County HS or the District Athletic Director.
- The meal that is served at the banquet shall be at the discretion of the coaches involved in that sport and dependent upon the available funds to cover said expenses. The cost of the food and preparation shall not exceed \$500 per team/per sport for their banquet. Any exceptions to this policy will be addressed on an 'at needs basis' and must be approved by the Principal or District Athletic Director.

- Awards presented to student-athletes shall not exceed \$40 per award. Awards given to student-athletes shall be at the discretion of the coaches of the individual team. Any exceptions to this policy shall be addressed on an 'at needs basis' and must be approved by the Principal or District Athletic Director.
