There is no guarantee on the availability of utilizing a van even when the total number of passengers are within the limits and cargo considerations. The district owns one van and has access to one to two van rentals through a local dealership. All van usage is scheduled based on first come, first serve basis. If a van is not available, a school bus must be used.
