Uniform Replacement Policy

*Football, Girl's Basketball, and Boy's Basketball will operate on four year cycles. Year one they will purchase home uniforms. Year two they will purchase away uniforms. Year three they will purchase warm-ups or in Football's case game pants. Year four they will not purchase. These three sports will be staggered so the fourth year will be on a different year.

All three will jump into the cycle starting with the 2011 season. Football will be in year one in 2011, Girl's Basketball will be in year two in 2011, and Boy's Basketball will be in year three in 2011.

Assigned budgets will be used to purchased uniforms.

*Baseball, Softball, Girl's and Boy's Track, and Volleyball will also be on four year cycles. The following schedule will be used for uniform replacement.

Volleyball 2010-2011, Baseball 2011-2012, Girl's and Boy's Track 2012-2013, and Softball 2013-2014.

The schedule will then roll over and start again.

*Uniforms will be reveiwed for safety and condition on an annual basis by the coaches and Athletic Director.

*Student athletes that are assigned a uniform are responsible for the uniforms and other equipment. All uniforms and equipment must be returned to the school sponsor after the season is complete or the student will be charged the full price for the uniform or other item in question.

*Changes in coaches or style or fashion do not warrant the purchasing of new uniforms if the current uniform is still in good condition.

*If the majority of the team's uniforms are in good or excellent condition and less than $\frac{1}{4}$ in fair or poor condition, replacing the entire set is not necessary if matching replacement uniforms can be purchased.

*Whenever possible, varsity uniforms will be passed down to the junior varsity and junior varsity uniforms will be passed down to the Middle School. This will not be done if the uniforms are in poor condition or do not fit the majority of the team properly.
