Outdoor Batting Cage Rotation Plan

On days in which both the baseball and softball teams are hosting home games the following batting cage rotation plan will be implemented:

- 1. Which ever game is scheduled to start first will have first access to the batting. Time will be limited to 30 minutes per team.
- 2. If both games are scheduled to start at the same time, then the coaches must submit a schedule to the Athletic Director at least one week in advance for final approval.
- 3. If a plan has not been submitted to the Athletic Director then a schedule will be posted at the discretion the athletic department.

Plan for Retired Jerseys, Numbers, Team Pictures, and Other Special Awards

If any coach, member of the school, or community feels there is a player, coach, team, or individual who is in need of any type of special recognition (team picture, retired jersey, number, etc.) then a written request must be sent to the Athletic Director. All pertinent information (statistics, championship awards, community contribution) that you would like to have considered should be included in the request. Once a request has been submitted the proposal will be reviewed by the Principal, Assistant Principal, and Athletic Director. The review committee will inform the parties involved in the request within 14 days of receiving the report. If the request is approved the review committee will determine the type of special recognition and the where the award will be displayed.
