



Unified Bowling Tournament Score Sheet

Format:

- Teams will bowl one baker game and that score will determine their seed.
- Baker Games will be bowled with the following conditions:
 - Partner Athlete must bowl frames 1, 3, 5, 7, 9
 - Special Athlete must bowl frames 2, 4, 6, 8, 10
 - Each athlete will bowl all balls within their frame.
- The team will then bowl whichever team they are seed to bowl in a match.
- The winner will advance to the next round.
- Each round will consist of one baker game
- Rounds will continue until a champion, runner-up and semifinalist are established.
- Results need to be entered into the Regional Workbook tab under Unified.
- Please enter head to head scores within the bracket before submitting.
