To Members of the Association:

The secretary of the Tennessee Association has asked me to notify you that the Rhea Central High School of Dayton, Tennessee, and Knox County Central High School of Fountain City, Tennessee, have been suspended from that association for one year, and our members are asked to schedule no games with those two schools during the period of their suspension.

I enclose herewith the minutes of the recent annual meeting, and the annual audit of the association for the period July 1st 1936 to May 15th 1937. I wish to send this to you before the close of school since I shall not be your secretary next fall at the time when the minutes and audit have heretofore been sent out. The annual meeting gave me permission to close the books for this year on this date.

During the sixteen years in which I have been a member of your Board of Control, the first year as vice president, and since then as secretary-treasurer, the association has grown from 120 members to 572. It is a satisfaction to have had some part in the development of this fine organization, along with the splendid men who have during the years been fellow members of the Board of Control.

This will be my last letter to you. Correspondence should be addressed after June to Theo A. Sanford, Secretary-Treasurer, Danville, Kentucky. I bespeak for him the same excellent cooperation and assistance that I have received. On July 1st I shall close our accounts with the Citizens Union National Bank, and send Mr. Sanford a Cashier's Check for the funds of the association, amounting to \$7,613.02 as shown in the audit, plus interest on the savings accounts for the six months period ending on that date. There are no checks outstanding. All bills are paid, and as far as I know, I shall have no others to pay. The files, typewriter, mimeograph, and other effects of the association will be shipped to Mr. Sanford in due time.
