2. Steve Riley made a motion to comply with the NFHS rule change and move the Fast Pitch Softball pitching distance from 40 to 43 feet, effective for the 2009-2010 school year. The motion was seconded by Jerry Keepers, and passed unanimously.

3. Stan Steidel requested that middle school football be discussed at a future meeting. He also asked the Board to write a letter to the Sports Safety Work Group encouraging support of middle schools utilizing any high school safety protocols, including heat index and sports first aid.

4. The September Board meeting will be conducted as a one day meeting, on Monday,

September 14, 2009.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Ozz Jackson made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Bob Schneider, and passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 12:45 p.m. on August 24, 2009.
