Richard Moloney Disie Heights (1949-1952)

Richard D. Moloney was a 1952 graduate of Dixie Heights High School.

Moloney was a great allaround athlete at the school excelling in football, basketball and track for Dixie Heights.

Richard was a two time letterman in football for the Colonels.

Moloney was the team captain and earned the honors of "best All Around Back" and "Best tackler."

He was first team halfback on the Northern Kentucky Athletic Conference All Opponent Team.

Richard received Honorable Mention on the Associated Press All Star Team and was the starting halfback for the Kentucky East-West All Star Game in 1951.

The versatile athlete also excelled for the Dixie Heights bas-ketball team.


He was a two time letterman and captain of the team as well. He received Honorable Mention for the NKAC All Opponent Team.

Moving on to track, Moloney was part of a three way first place finish for the pole vault at the Regional Track Meet.

He also finished third in the 100 yard dash and placed third in pole vault at the KHSAA State Meet.

Moloney, following graduation from Dixie moved on to play football at the University of Kentucky.

There he had the opportunity to play for the legendary Paul

"Bear" Bryant.

Under Bryant's tutelage, Moloney played fullback, halfback and end.

Jack Ramey, noted Kentucky Post columnist wrote on December 8, 1953 "He (Moloney) played the Bear's game of unselfish, masterful football. He's (Moloney) a team man, working hard to master any position the bear suggests. The Bear can use more boys from Northern Kentucky like Moloney."

He played briefly for the New York Giants and then became a successful businessman culminating as Executive Vice President of KY
