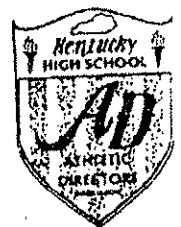

A lifelong resident of Northern Kentucky, Dan is probably best known as a high school and college basketball official. His career has included several trips to the "Sweet Sixteen".

DAN SULLIVAN
BELLEVUE HIGH SCHOOL — 1949-1953

Dan Sullivan has distinguished himself throughout Northern Kentucky and the State of Kentucky for his excellence in all areas of athletics and education. He has shown these fine qualities over the years as a student-athlete; a teacher-coach; a high school principal; an assistant superintendent; a superintendent and prominent basketball official.

He began his athletic career by playing five sports at Bellevue High School where he earned ten letters in football, basketball, baseball, track and tennis.

Playing his football and basketball under Coach Ben Flora, he was instrumental in helping the Tigers in having outstanding football and basketball teams in the late 40's and early 50's. Coach Bob Miller was his track coach, Coach Bob Himmeler his basketball coach, and Coach Roger Klein was his coach in Tennis.

Dan who was a member of the 1951 State Football Championship Team was also selected on the NKAC Football, Basketball and Baseball teams.

After graduating from high school, he accepted an athletic scholarship at Union College (Kentucky). While at Union he lettered two years in basketball and four years in baseball. He was named to the All-Conference Team in Baseball.

In 1951, after receiving his BS Degree from Union College he accepted the head football coaching position at Ludlow High School. He inherited a program that had averaged less than two wins per season since 1944. Coach Sullivan rebuilt the program to a point that from 1960-1965 the school record rose to 39-21.

In 1966, he resigned from Ludlow to accept the Head Football coaching position at Lockland High School in Lockland, Ohio. After one year and a most successful season where he was named the "Southwestern Ohio Coach of the Year". He moved to Millford High School (Ohio) to accept a similar position. At Millford he rebuilt their program which had not had a winning season in ten years. Dan built them into a winning team his second year.

In 1969, he returned to Ludlow High School as the high school principal. In 1973, he moved to Newport Schools to become an assistant superintendent and in 1977 became the superintendent of the Newport Schools.

At the present time he serves as the Superintendent of Schools for Campbell County, a position he has held since 1984.

On May 31, 1988, Dan Sullivan was honored by the Northern Kentucky Chamber of Commerce when they awarded him the "A. D. Albright Award" which was given to the top educator of the 1987-88 school year.

Along with his many years of teaching, coaching and being a fine education administrator, Dan Sullivan has contributed greatly to Northern Kentucky Athletics. He was one of the most respected basketball officials in the last decade. He was a very prominent official throughout the state and officiated in the 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, and 16th regional tournaments on numerous occasions. He also officiated in the KHSAA State Tournaments in 1977-1983-1987.

He and his wife Mae reside in Fort Thomas, Kentucky.

BELLEVUE HIGH SCHOOL 1944-1953

DAN SULLIVAN HAS DISTINGUISHED HIMSELF THROUGHOUT NORTHERN KENTUCKY AND THE STATE OF KENTUCKY FOR HIS EXCELLENCE IN ALL AREAS OF ATHLETICS AND EDUCATION. HE HAS SHOWN THESE FINE QUALITIES OVER THE YEARS AS A STUDENT-ATHLETE; A TEACHER-COACH; A HIGH SCHOOL PRINCIPAL; A ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT; A SUPERINTENDENT AND PROMINENT BASKETBALL OFFICIAL.

HE BEGAN HIS ATHLETIC CAREER BY PLAYING FIVE SPORTS AT BELLEVUE HIGH SCHOOL WHERE HE EARNED TEN LETTERS IN FOOTBALL, BASKETBALL, BASEBALL, TRACK AND TENNIS.

PLAYING HIS FOOTBALL AND BASKETBALL UNDER COACH BOB FLORA HE WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN HELPING THE TIGERS IN HAVING OUTSTANDING FOOTBALL AND BASKETBALL TEAMS IN THE LATE 40'S AND EARLY 50'S. COACH BOB MILLER WAS HIS TRACK COACH, COACH BOB HIMMELER HIS BASEBALL COACH, AND COACH ROGER KLEIN WAS HIS COACH IN TENNIS.

DAN WHO WAS A MEMBER OF THE 1951 STATE FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM WAS ALSO SELECTED ON THE NKA C FOOTBALL BASKETBALL AND BASEBALL TEAM.

AFTER GRADUATING FROM HIGH SCHOOL HE ACCEPTED A ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP AT UNION COLLEGE (KY)

WHICH AT UNION HE LETTHERED TWO YEARS IN BASKETBALL

IN 1957, AFTER RECEIVING HIS BS DEGREE FROM UNION COLLEGE HE ACCEPTED THE HEAD FOOTBALL COACHING POSITION AT LUDLOW HIGH SCHOOL. HE INHERITED A PROGRAM THAT HAD AVERAGED LESS THAN TWO WINS PER SEASON SINCE 1944. COACH SULLIVAN REBUILT THE PROGRAM TO A POINT THAT FROM 1960-65 THE SCHOOL RECORD ROSE TO 39-21.

IN 1966, HE RESIGNED FROM LUDLOW TO ACCEPT THE HEAD FOOTBALL COACHING POSITION AT LOCKLAND HIGH SCHOOL IN LOCKLAND, OHIO. AFTER ONE YEAR AND A MOST SUCCESSFUL SEASON WHERE HE WAS NAMED THE "SOUTHWESTERN OHIO COACH OF THE YEAR" HE MOVED TO MILFORD HIGH SCHOOL (OHIO) TO ACCEPT A SIMILAR POSITION.

AT MILFORD HE REBUILT THEIR PROGRAM, WHICH HAD NOT HAD A WINNING SEASON IN TEN YEARS. DAN BUILT THEM INTO WINNING TEAM HIS SECOND YEAR.

IN 1969 HE RETURNED TO LUDLOW HIGH SCHOOL AS THE HIGH SCHOOL PRINCIPAL. IN 1973 HE MOVED TO THE NEWPORT SCHOOLS TO BECOME AN ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT AND IN ~~1987~~ 1977 BECAME THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE NEWPORT SCHOOLS.

AT THE PRESENT TIME HE SERVES AS THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS FOR CAMPBELL COUNTY IN A POSITION. HE HAS HELD SINCE 1988

ON MAY 31, 1988 DAN SULLIVAN WAS HONORED BY THE NORTHERN KENTUCKY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE WHEN THEY AWARDED HIM THE "A. D. ALBRIGHT AWARD" WHICH WAS GIVEN TO THE TOP EDUCATOR OF THE 1987-88 SCHOOL YEAR.

ALONG WITH HIS MANY YEARS OF TEACHING, COACHING AND BEING A ^{FINE} EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATOR, DAN SULLIVAN HAS CONTRIBUTED GREATLY TO NORTHERN KENTUCKY ATHLETICS. HE WAS ONE OF THE MOST RESPECTED BASKETBALL OFFICIALS IN ^{THE} LAST DECADE. HE WAS A ^{VERY} PROMINENT OFFICIAL THROUGHOUT THE STATE, ^{AND} OFFICIATED IN THE 8TH, 9TH, 10TH, 11TH, 12TH, AND 16TH REGIONAL TOURNAMENTS ON NUMEROUS OCCASSIONS. HE ALSO OFFICIATED IN THE KHSAA STATE TOURNAMENT IN 1977-1983-1987
